BARLEY

Dual purpose Winter barley

NEW Newton

Long season 'Graze and Grain' variety from SECOBRA.
Slow developing winter type enabling early sowing and long grazing.
High tillering, very competitive plant type.
Harvest maturity similar to mid-winter wheats and produces 2-row feed grain.

Laperouse^ϕ

Mid-maturing spring variety from SECOBRA.
Medium plant height selected for good stem strength and low head loss.
Large grain size with low screenings and high retention.

Malting barley

Leabrook^ϕ

Mid-early maturity, medium-tall plant with high grain yield and good grain size.

Bottler^ϕ

High yielding mid-high rainfall variety that produces highly regarded export quality malt.

OATS

Variety under milling evaluation

NEW Koala^ϕ

Last grain oat variety released from SARDI breeding program.
High yield potential, mid to long season maturity, tall dwarf plant type.
Under evaluation for milling approval.

Broadly adapted high yielding tall dwarf milling variety

Yallara^ϕ

Dual purpose medium-tall variety for hay or milling grain production

WHEAT

Milling wheat

Reilly^ϕ

Main season AH variety for SA, VIC and southern NSW.
New genetic background offers advantage for disease resistance and high yield stability in a range of conditions.

Kingston^ϕ

Main season AH variety for SA, VIC and southern NSW.
Excellent standability and high grain yield.
Short compact plant height with low residues, ideal for high input irrigation.

Ascot^ϕ

Mid to long season southern region variety with APW classification in VIC & SA. Good plant type and high grain yield.

DS Bennett^ϕ

Long season winter wheat with tall plant type and awn-less head, ASW in SA, VIC & Sth NSW

Durum wheat

DBA Mataroi^ϕ

Last durum variety released by NSW DPI Tamworth.
Early-mid maturing with improved yield over previous Tamworth varieties.
Durum classification in Northern and South Eastern zones.

DBA Vittaroi^ϕ

Early-mid maturing variety well suited to high input irrigation.
Replacement for EGA Bellaroi.

This symbol indicates that a variety is protected by **Plant Breeders Rights (PBR)**.



All Seednet varieties are protected by PBR and unauthorised commercial propagation or any sale, conditioning, export, import or stocking of propagating material is an infringement under the PBR Act (1994).

To purchase and grow Seednet PBR varieties, growers are required to agree to terms and conditions of the Seednet Variety License. This is a Standard Industry Agreement adopted by the majority of crop variety breeders and commercialisation companies in Australia.

The License outlines all obligations of the purchaser, including what they can/cannot do with the seed and resulting grain production, payment of End Point Royalties (EPR's) and reporting of harvest details. As there are no signatures required on the License, growers are taken to have read, understood and accepted the terms by accepting or using the seed.
